RE: U.S. RV DEALER INVENTORIES DOWN 21,200 UNITS THIS YEAR

The attached chart shows the significant decline of 21,200 units in U.S. dealer

inventories this year through October 31, 2007. It shows clearly that dealers have

substantially reduced inventories in line with declines in the industry which is

good news and bodes well for a positive 2008.

NOTE:

RV wholesale shipments reported by RVIA include shipments to Canada.

Statistical Surveys retail numbers do not include Canada. Wholesale shipments

have been reduced based on the % of 2006 (latest available) shipments to Canada.

We are confident that U.S. shipments to Canada in 2007 are higher than in 2006

due to the 14% devaluation of the U.S. dollar against the Canadian dollar this

year. Therefore, U.S. wholesale shipments are probably understated, resulting in

even higher declines in dealer inventories than shown.
